

How to Look Good...What To Wear....a few suggestions for business portraits.

Ladies:

- Generally, solid colours work best, try to avoid bold patterns and stripes.
- Darker colours tend to minimise, lighter tones maximise.
- Long sleeved blouses/tops are sometimes more flattering than sleeveless.
- Plain two piece jacket/suit (does not have to be black). Plain light blouse/top
- Simple jewellery & accessories. Borrow from a good friend!
- Your make up needs to be the same as if you were going somewhere nice!

Men:

- If your profession allows, then a medium/dark suit, white or blue shirt & plain coloured tie... for a more relaxed look then casual jacket & polo shirt, basically dress how you want to be seen.
- Avoid patterns & logos. Solid colours work best.
- Wear suitable trousers as they may be seen in some shots.
- If you need a haircut, do it one week before your session, now is not the time to try out the mohican!

Finally:

- Look the part...Whatever your occupation, look professional.
- First impressions count, your photo may be the initial contact.
- Do not allow yourself to be distracted, being photographed in front of ten office colleagues is not a good idea.
